



Summer Science Inquiry Institute

July 31st-August 4th 2017

Offered in partnership with the Franklin Institute, the Summer Science Inquiry Institute provides a full week of summer professional development for teachers. Teachers will visit 5 different locations across the city that provide resources for science education. They will learn principals of inquiry based and project based learning as well as how to connect students to real world, relevant science topics.

Where: The week will begin at the Franklin Institute on July 31st and end at Riverbend Environmental Education Center on August 4th. We will visit different locations throughout the week and teachers are responsible for their own transportation each day.

What to bring: We will spend a lot of time outdoors. Bring a bagged lunch, water bottle and something to write with. Wear comfortable clothes and shoes.

Cost: This program is free to Philadelphia School District teachers. A \$100 deposit is required to hold your space and will be returned upon completion of the institute.

Note: The Summer Science Institute is a pre-requisite to the Teacher Fellowship
