PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS



Ages 3 – 4 (Half Day 9am – 12pm, includes time for lunch) Tadpoles will explore nature through activities that engage the 5 senses and encourage curiosity.

Rangers

Age 4 (Full Day 9am - 3:30pm)

Rangers will create and imagine through hands on science activities and nature exploration.

Adventurers

Ages 5 – 6

Adventurers will explore natural habitats and conduct investigations to discover something new.

Explorers

Ages 7 - 8

Explorers will experiment in nature and embark on a field trip to a regional destination. Optional campfire cook out on Thursday night each week (additional fee applies).

Discoverers

Ages 9 – 11

Discoverers will practice new skills, hike to new places, enjoy a field trip, and sleep under the stars. Optional camp-out on Thursday night each week.

Navigators

Ages 10 – 13 Overnight Excursion Camps

Navigators will enjoy an action-packed adventure, traveling to new places on uniquely themed field trips and overnight tent-camping experiences.

NEW! Navigators Leadership Academy (2 week session) Ages 11 - 14

Navigators Leadership Academy is a 2-week experience where campers will enjoy nature excursions, camping, meet experts in the scientific field, build leadership and teamwork skills, and earn volunteer service hours. Leadership skills will include mentoring younger campers.
