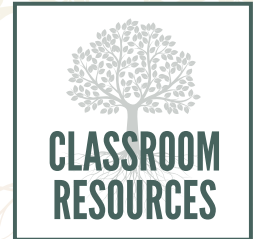

This program includes a 3-day summer institute, 10 virtual meetings for educators, classroom visits, outdoor education experiences and classroom resources.

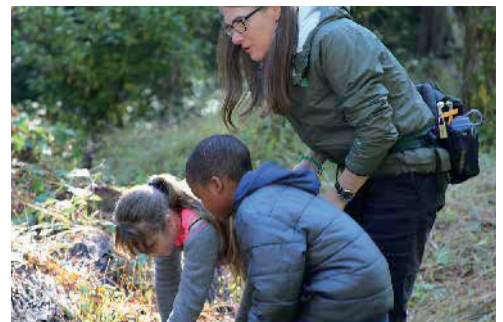


Eligibility:
