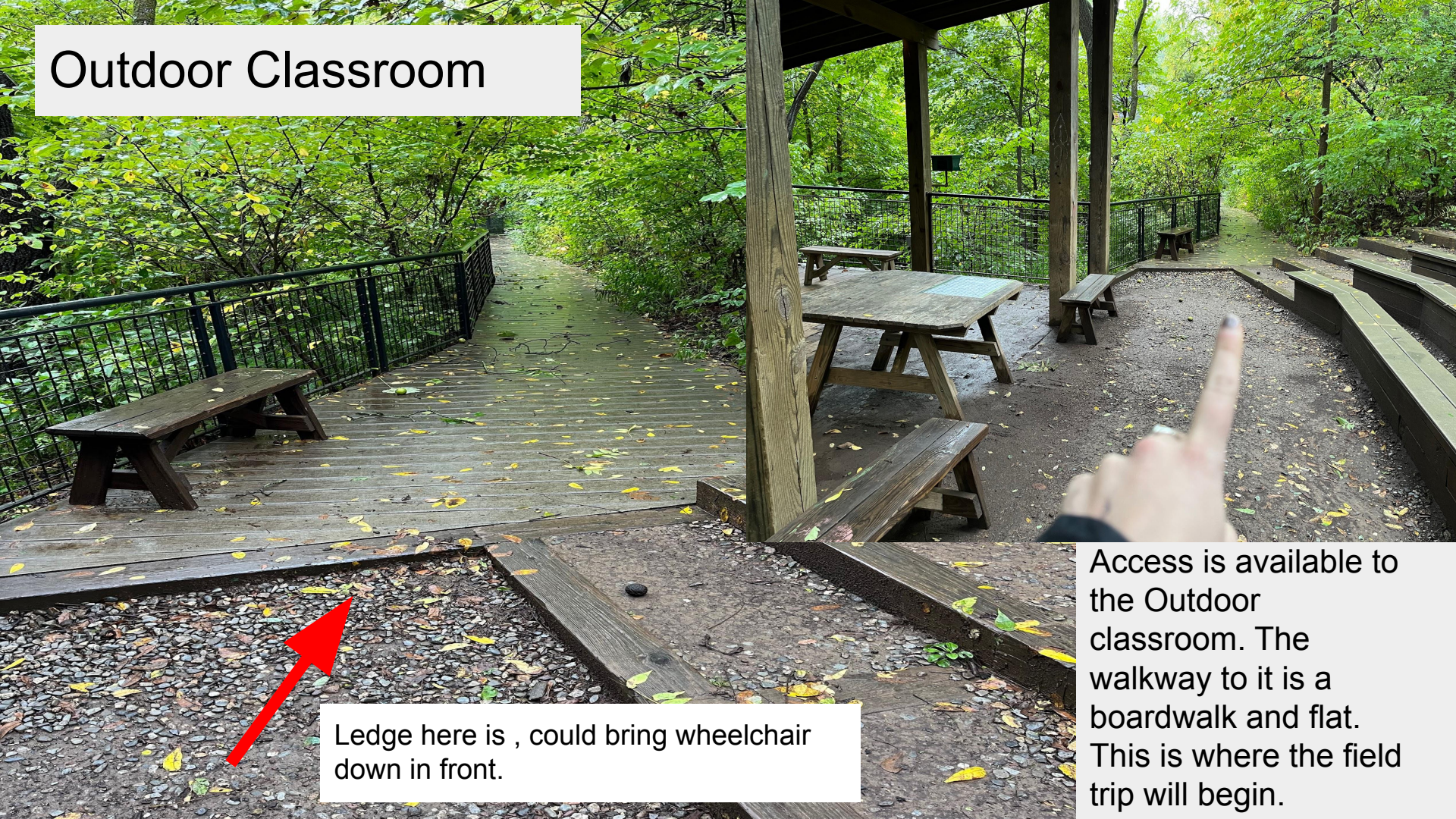
Accessibility at the

Entrance

The parking lot is completely paved, as well as the walkway up to the barn. It is situated on a hill with an incline that may require assistance.



Outdoor Classroom



Ledge here is , could bring wheelchair down in front.

Access is available to the Outdoor classroom. The walkway to it is a boardwalk and flat. This is where the field trip will begin.



Stream

Through the parking lot, there is access to the stream. The path is wider than pictured and would allow wheelchair access.

Stream



This is the path from the parking lot to the stream. The trail could be cleared more if needed. There are a few roots and rocks that cannot be moved, but may require some assistance navigating in a wheelchair.



A student in a wheelchair could be situated on the river bank, pictured above. The educator would be able to bring specimens to the student and conduct the introduction, exploration, and wrap up in this area.

Aquaponics Greenhouse

Pictured is the decking around the Barn. The Aquaponics greenhouse is at the back right of the barn. There is a short ramp and the student can enter the greenhouse. Bathrooms are accessible inside this barn.

Bathrooms

The bathrooms (2) are located inside the barn, next to the Aquaponics Greenhouse. Both are handicap accessible.



Meadow

The Meadow station will take place at this location. It is right off the pavement leading to the path.

Student can complete the activity in the highlighted area of the meadow.



Valley View Trail is not accessible to all wheelchairs, so we will stay at the bottom as a group along the side to complete our meadow exploration.

Picnic Area

This patio where the majority of students will have lunch. There is another area with rectangular picnic tables that also could be utilized, but is on a steeper slope.
